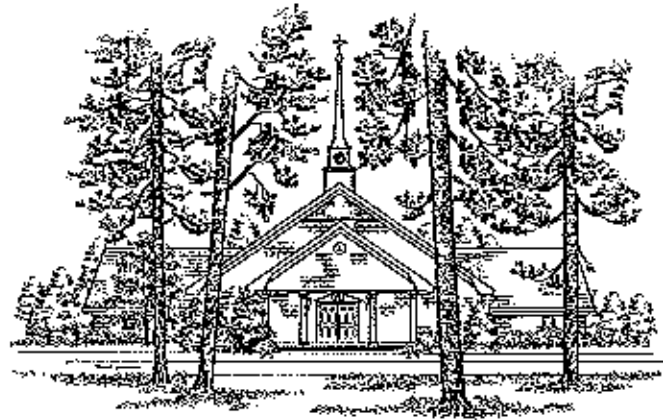

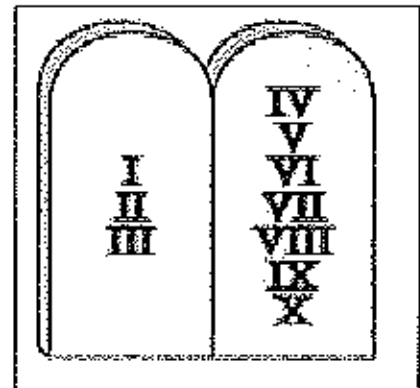

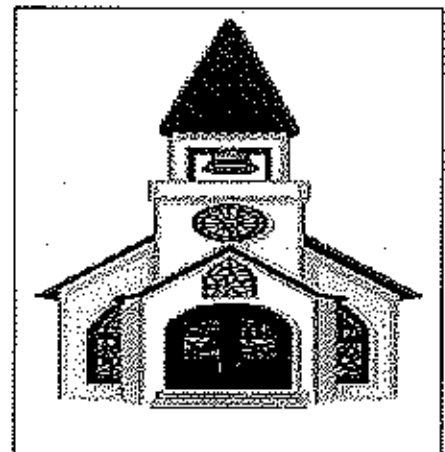

RESOLVE TO TAKE BACK WHAT IS OURS IN 2010!

Ok, let's admit that we all make some sort of flimsy New Years resolution every year. Some of us will be making the same resolution this year that we for have the last 10 years. Resolutions can be fun for some of us, and others are quickly let down as they give in to the temptations that they resolved to never give in to EVER again. I want to make a suggestion: go ahead and make those hard-to-reach resolutions, but also make one that is very reachable and obtainable. Many of you are saying "What in the world could this preacher be talking about?" Well, Scripture tells us that if we have accepted Christ and are following God's direction in our lives, then certain things belong to us.

The Apostle Paul tells us in the fifth chapter of Galatians that Christ has liberated us into freedom.
